Synopsis

Excited about the AI takeover? Lol at a future where robots capture stray humans.

Set in the (terrifyingly) near future, HUMAN-B-GON follows a crew of emotionally unstable robots as they capture stray humans, which the machines now regard as inarticulate chattering pests.

Using Reality TV as a sonic template, HUMAN-B-GON is a darkly comic look at self-awareness, insecurity, love, denial, existential dread, class struggle, and humanity's adorable sense of self-importance.

The idea for Human-B-Gon came from Drew worrying about the advance of AI, thinking The Terminator movies' view of the future is adorably optimistic, and wondering if self-awareness will render machines as neurotic, insecure, and emotional as we are.
